## Mental Health Service Provider Registry: Requirements for Inclusion in the Registry

We are seeking Mental Health Providers to deliver support for our growing list of partners in integrated, multidisciplinary mental health services to amateur athletes, coaches, and families all around the United States in-person or remotely. While understanding sport is an integral part of being involved in our registry, we really are seeking to use sport as a medium to identify and deliver mental health supportive services. Therefore, high level knowledge of sport or high-performance athletes is helpful but NOT required. We currently are serving over 3 million youth and amateur athletes in every state in the US and continue to grow the number of partners and athletes we are serving.

To be considered for the United States Center for Mental Health and Sport National Registry, you must meet for following criteria:

1. Active US license in designated field.
2. Experience working with individuals from diverse cultural and ethnic backgrounds and abilities.
3. Knowledge of youth/amateur sport culture and associated relationships (i.e. coaches, administrators, recruiters, service providers, etc.).
4. No felony or health care fraud convictions.
5. No disciplinary actions on clinical license(s).
6. No actions, sanctions or discipline on clinical privileges or employment as the result of sexual abuse/harassment or substance abuse.
7. The USC-MHS must be notified by the registry member of any pending criminal charges or disciplinary action by any medical organization, board, or licensing agency as soon as they are filed at any time while serving in the USC-MHS mental health registry program.
8. Must have malpractice insurance:
  - a. Policy minimum is \$1,000,000 - \$3,000,000
  - b. Provide a current copy of the declarations page
  - c. Registry members must disclose any malpractice claims
9. Make a suggested donation of at least \$100 annually to the United States Center for Mental Health and Sport (a 501c3 fully tax-deductible entity).
10. Meet the profession-specific requirements in the following table and provide the requisite documents.
